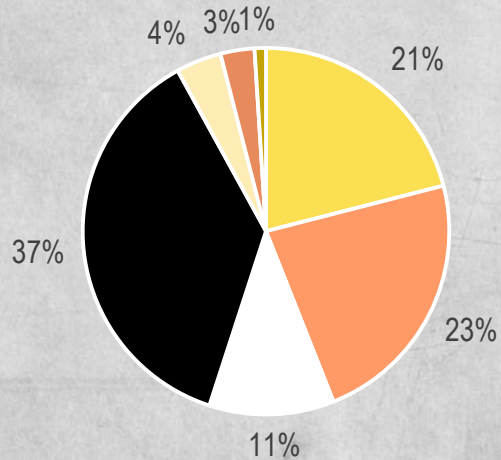


Number of Veterans Receiving Benefits

- Approximately 3.9 million veterans of all eras receiving disability
 - 66% of pending claims are supplemental
 - 34% original claim
 - 10% have supplemental claims pending
 - 77% of supplemental claims are receiving some level of monetary benefit
 - 11% of supplemental already at 100%
 - 40% rated 50% of higher
 - 43% of supplemental are Vietnam Era
 - 19% are Post 9/11
- FY 2012
 - VA delivered \$54 Billion in Compensation/Pension Benefits

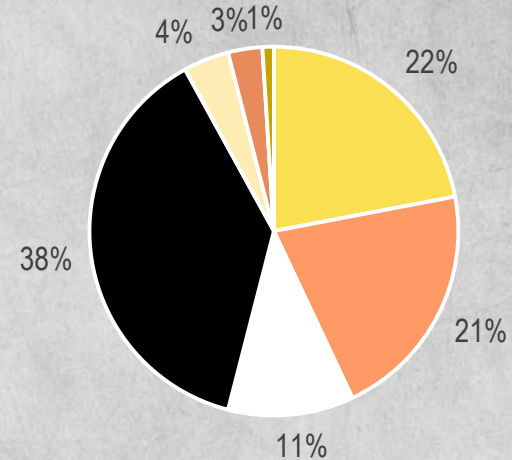
Statistics by Conflict

 - 725,469
 - 421,793 or 58.1% over 125 days*
- Compensation
 - 670,764
 - 401,952 or 59.9% over 125 days
- Increased Evaluation and/or Additional Claimed Condition
 - 432,172
 - 260,701 or 60.3% over 125 days
- Dependency Award Adjustments
 - 212,434
 - 152,005 or 71.6% over 125 days
- Program Reviews**
 - 72,716
 - 56,671 or 77.9% over 125 days
- Appeals
 - 258,077 pending, all types
